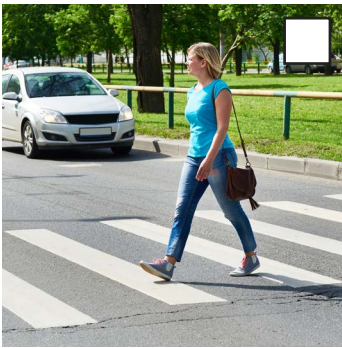


Traffic Safety Scavenger Hunt

Be on the lookout for the features that keep us safe around traffic! Check off the items you see on our roadways, sidewalks and parks as you learn the best ways to travel safely.

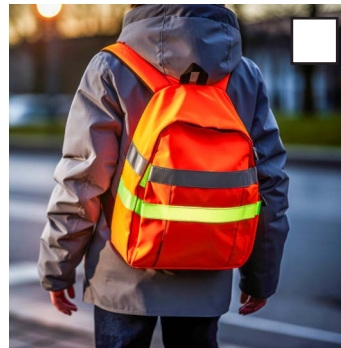

reminds drivers to stop completely



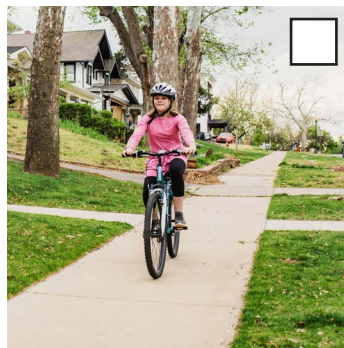
Reflective Strip
help everyone see signs and lanes at night



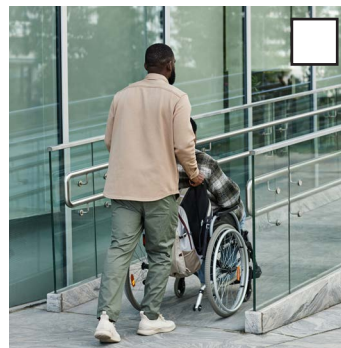
Bike Lanes

look for people walking safely by sidewalk or crosswalk



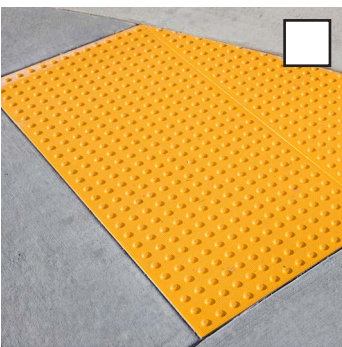
Sidewalk
specially made for pedestrians and bicyclists



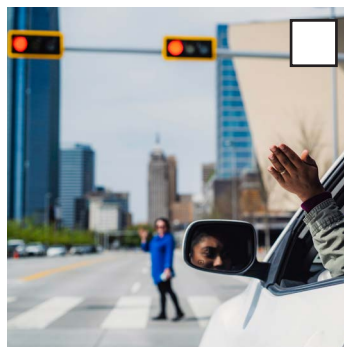
Curb Ramp
a slope that helps people with strollers, wheelchairs, or bikes



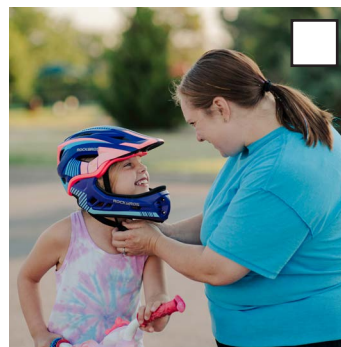
"Walk" Signal
this little guy tells us when it's ok to enter the street



Guard Bumps
these bumpy surfaces alert people with vision impairment to crosswalks and intersections



Traffic Light
tells drivers and pedestrians when to go or stop



Bike & Helmet
look for a bicyclist riding safely with a helmet on
